3. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff.
4. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
5. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required
6. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
7. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
8. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
9. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
10. Service conditions pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
11. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

17. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
18. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **2730543**. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
19. Annual fee of Rs.4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum for three years **1.04.2007 to 31.03.2010** be also remitted at an early date.
20. The school should apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of Affiliation 'On Line' through CBSE Website www.cbseaff.nic.in or www.cbse.nic.in and send a copy of its confirmation page with prescribed fee of Rs.12,500/- in the shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Secretary, CBSE, Delhi.
21. Renewal of Registration of Society be ensured.
22. "The school will be eligible to open CBSE pattern class IX w.e.f. the session **1.4.2007**. Accordingly 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in the year **2009**."
23. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.

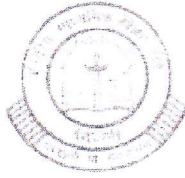
Conditions for which Compliance to be submitted with in three months from the date of issue of sanction letter :-

1. Running /Starting of class IX/X or XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level /Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorised and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non submission of application for extension of Provisional Affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE Affiliated school Building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one Society /Management / Trust to another Society / Management / Trust through agreement /sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effects.
5. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that to the State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and staff be given appointment / Confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV
8. The School shall maintain Section teacher Ratio at least 1:1:5 at each level i.e. primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. secondary (XI-XII)
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of women from sexual harrasment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No. 666-70 of 1992 Vishakha and others state of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13/08/1997.
10. Rs. 4500/- on account of annual fee for 03 years may please be remitted.

1. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board
2. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires as per Rule 15.11 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
3. The School must follow Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI-IX from Academic year 2017-18 onwards as per the Board's Circular No.Acad-14/2017 dated 21/03/2017.
4. The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular No.CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016 dated 10/11/2016 within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: "www.cbse.nic.in"
5. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
6. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt from time to time.
7. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

8. The school should scrupulously observe prescription from the Municipal Authority/District Collectorate/Transport Department regarding drinking water, fire safety and transport precautions in the school. A certificate from the Municipal/Fire/transport Authority regarding sanitary conditions, water/fire/transport safety should be submitted every five years as per Rule 8.5 of Affiliation Bye Laws and shall follow Rule no. 3.3(vii) and Rule 23(xi) in this regard.

9. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
10. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
11. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
12. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1.20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
13. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
15. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
16. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 & 3. Also, as per Chapter II, Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be commensurate with the facilities provided by the institution.
17. The school should not engage in **commercialization activities**:
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
 - b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
18. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
19. School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
20. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
21. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
22. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory **as per the State Education Act**.
23. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government/Govt. of India. Further, **Salary and Service conditions** of staff should be provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.

- 24 As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, postal address and e mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye Laws and upload the same on the website before 15th September of every year. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own **website** containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, postal address and e mail telephone number etc.
- 25 Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv). Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.
- 26 As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 27 Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 28 As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the '**Persons with Disabilities Act 1995**'.
- 29 **School infrastructure and teachers for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 30 As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 31 Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- 32 Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i a w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- 33 As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
- 34 As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
- 35 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
- 36 The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 37 It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 38 The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
- 39 The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.
- 40 In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.

Subject: Grant of approval/ permission on one time basis in respect of applications registered under SARAS for session 2022-23 due to COVID- 19 pandemic situation- reg.

The Board has implemented the School Affiliation Re-engineered Automated System (SARAS) from March, 2021 in tune with the mandate of the National Education Policy 2020. The essence of the system is disposal of the cases in a time-bound manner so as to avoid undue harassment to the stakeholders.

It has been noticed that the schools are facing problems in procuring mandatory documents required as per Affiliation Bye Laws 2018, as the Govt. offices in the States are not functioning with full strength due to COVID-19 pandemic. In absence of mandatory certificate(s), the applications under SARAS for session 2022-23 are getting rejected and school needs to apply afresh with requisite fees.

Therefore, in order to avoid hardship to the schools/ students, the Competent Authority of the Board, after due consideration has accorded one time relaxation for furnishing relevant safety certificates, thereby granting approval to the schools that had applied under SARAS for the following categories of school for session 2022-23:-

Sl. No.	Category of Application
01	Extension of Affiliation
02	Section increase
03	Introduction of Additional Subject
04	Permission of two Shifts
05	Permission of name change of school/ society (As per status of school)
06	Transfer of school from one society to another

However, for categories under serial no. 02 to 06, applicant schools must ensure submission in the SARAS portal category specific documentary requirement as per the Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018.

However, the above mentioned categories schools must update the Mandatory Certificates under the Mandatory Public Disclosure on the school website with a prominent icon levelled as "Mandatory Public Disclosure" in compliance to Board's Circular No. 09/2021 dated 21.05.2021, during the running of the school to ensure safety of the students.

In this regards, the applicant schools must ensure the following directions of the Board:-

1. All cases of extension of affiliation registered upto session 2022-23 shall be granted extension for a period of 05 years irrespective of the stage where application is pending i.e. be at scrutiny level, Inspection Committee level, Deficiency/ compliance level etc.

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2. The school shall ensure the availability of fire safety, building safety and all other mandatory certificates which should be valid and renewed on the day of operation and during running of the school, so that the safety of the students are ensured.
3. The school shall maintain records of certificates, compliances, data and other relevant information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities as and when asked for. Non-compliance of the norms shall attract penal provisions under clause 12 of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school will also ensure that it is in possession of the all documents/certificates as specified in clause 2.5.5 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018.
5. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice were communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take further decision in this matter in due course as per relevant clause(s) of Affiliation Bye-Laws 2018.
6. In respect of above mentioned categories of schools, the Board reserves the right to conduct inspection as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
7. In case of already rejected cases, registered in the SARAS portal for 2022-23 session, the cases shall be considered on suo-moto basis.
